## Spring Term 2011

### English

The children will be involved in the following literacy activities.

- ◆ Reading and writing stories/novels about imaginary worlds - sci-fi and fantasy adventures.
- ◆ Learning about classic and modern poetry including poems from different cultures and times.
- ◆ Looking at different types of information books and explanatory texts.
- ◆ Improving sentence construction and punctuation - word order, connectives commas, apostrophes.
- ◆ Examining comparative and superlative adjectives.
- ◆ Finding out about spelling rules.
- ◆ Learning spellings including weekly spelling tests.

### Mathematics

The children will study the following areas of the numeracy strategy.

- ◆ Tally charts, pictograms and bar charts.
- ◆ Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100, and rounding numbers.
- ◆ Mental strategies for working with multiples of 10 and 100.
- ◆ Developing mental strategies.
- ◆ Measuring mass and capacity.
- ◆ Properties of 3D shapes.
- ◆ Using and applying number
- ◆ Exploring integers.

- ◆ Multiplying and dividing by 6,7,8,9 and 11.
- ◆ Informal pencil and paper methods for multiplication.

### Science

- ◆ Keeping warm - A unit of work exploring heat in terms of measurement and insulation.
- ◆ Circuits and Conductors - A physics unit of work focusing on the properties of electricity including safety and its use within a circuit.

### Geography

- ◆ A Village in India - A look at the small village of Chembakoli.

### History

- ◆ Tudors - A unit exploring what life was like in Tudor times.

### ICT

- ◆ Developing images, repeating patterns.
- ◆ Collecting and presenting information.
