The children will look in detail at the following areas:

- Fiction from a range of different genres (including mystery, historical and fantasy)
- Story writing, focusing on flashback stories and story openings
- A range of non-fiction forms of writing, including discussions texts and adverts
- Consolidation of previous work on a range of punctuation (semi-colons, colons etc...)
- Revise previous work on complex sentences
- To use known spellings as a basis for spelling other words with similar patterns or related meanings.

- Place value, ordering and rounding
- Mental Calculation strategies and pencil and paper procedures multiplication and division)
- Understanding multiplication and division problem solving
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Shape and space (reasoning about shapes)
