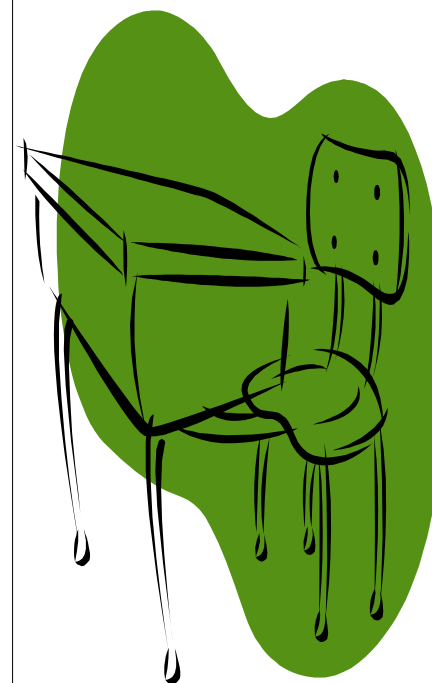

The children will be involved in the following literacy activities.

- To read and develop their knowledge myths, legends and fables.

- To look at explanatory and investigative texts.
- To use independent spelling strategies.
- To use extended punctuation effectively to construct different types of sentences.
- To read regularly from the reading scheme.
