## Summer Term 2011

### English

The children will engage in the following literacy activities:

- ◆ Identifying syllabic patterns in multi-syllabic words.
- ◆ Narrative text - identifying social, moral or cultural issues in stories.
- ◆ Poetry - verse, chorus, couplet, stanza, rhyme, rhythm and alliteration.
- ◆ Persuasive writing
- ◆ Read stories and poems by a favourite author, making comparisons.
- ◆ Non-fiction - Compare and evaluate, arguments and discussions.
- ◆ Improving sentence construction and punctuation, including speech marks, apostrophes and paragraphs.
- ◆ Spelling rules

### Mathematics

The following is a week-by-week account of the general learning area:

- ◆ Decimal notation to 2 decimal places.
- ◆ Comparing and ordering numbers.
- ◆ Extending written addition and subtraction methods.
- ◆ Measuring length, perimeter and area.
- ◆ Angle and rotation.
- ◆ Using and applying number.
- ◆ Investigating patterns and problems.
- ◆ Extending multiplication to 2 and 3 digit numbers.
- ◆ Introducing standard written methods for division.
- ◆ Ratio and proportion, and relating fractions to division.
- ◆ Information tables and timetables.

- ◆ Separating Solids and Liquids .
- ◆ Habitats - The environments in which different animals live, and how they adapt to their surroundings.
