The children will continue to prepare for their SATs tests in English, Mathematics and Science.

English

The children will develop the following skills:

- To prepare for the school drama production.
- To be familiar with the work of some established authors.
- To describe and evaluate the style of an individual writer and to read an example of their work.
- To write an extended story with chapters.
- To describe and evaluate the style of a particular poet and to write their own poetry.
- To prepare for and take part in a topical debate.

Mathematics

- Place value, ordering and rounding
- Mental calculation strategies
- Pencil and paper procedures
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Ratio and proportion
- Calculator skills
- Data Handling
- Transforming shapes

During the summer term we will complete our work on adaptation and interdependence as well as completing our SATs preparation.

Later in the term we will focus on scientific enquiry skills, culminating in a long investigation.
