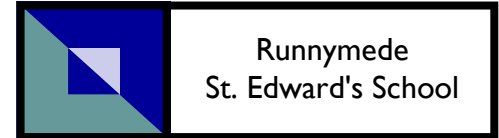

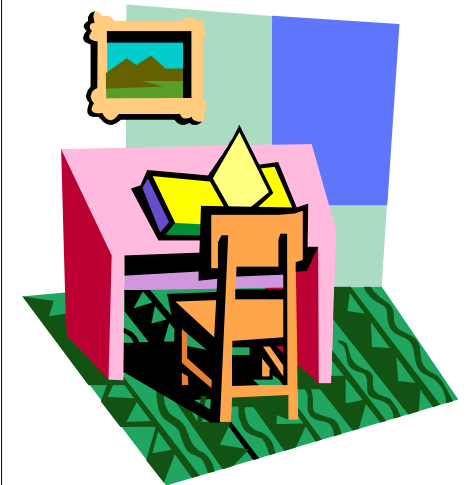

English

- ◆ The children will be involved in the following literacy activities.
- ◆ Looking at setting and characters in stories.
- ◆ Exploring chronology and narrative.
- ◆ Looking at narrative order and planning a story in paragraphs.
- ◆ Preparing reading and performing play-scripts.
- ◆ Creating play-scripts.
- ◆ Comparing and contrasting poems.
- ◆ Writing poems based upon personal or imagined experiences.
- ◆ Extending use of a range of punctuation features.
- ◆ Using the terms 'fact' and 'opinion'.
- ◆ Writing instructions and newspaper reports.
- ◆ Looking at simple spelling rules, plurals and suffixes.
- ◆ Learning spellings including weekly spelling tests.
