The children will be involved in the following literacy activities:

- To understand the difference between fiction and non-fiction
- To develop their understanding of the way information can be presented
 - Looking at stories with a familiar setting
 - Comparing a range of story settings
 - Developing the use of settings in own writing
 - How dialogue is presented in stories
 - To begin to organise stories into paragraphs
 - To be aware of the different voices in stories: narrator and character
 - To be aware of different forms of poetry: calligrams/shape poems
 - To look at simple spelling rules
