English

The children will look in detail at the following:

- Manipulating narrative perspective by writing a story with two different narrators
- Summarizing a passage, chapter or text
- Changing a story into a playscript
- Writing poetry
- Developing biographical and autobiographical writing
- Writing non-chronological reports
- Investigating spellings of connectives, word roots and unstressed vowels in polysyllabic words
- Using active and passive verbs and sophisticated punctuation marks such as the colon and semi-colon

Mathematics

The children will study the following areas:

- Place value, ordering and rounding
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Ratio and proportion
- Probability
- Calculator skills
- Handling data
- Shape and space
- Measures
- Addition and subtraction
- Properties of numbers

Science

During the autumn term we will study the following areas:

- Changing circuits
- How we see things
- Forces in Action
- Earth, sun and moon.
