Summer Term

English

The children will be involved in the following literacy activities:

- retelling main points of story in sequence and referring to aspects of the texts eg opening, build-up, atmosphere
- distinguishing between 1st and 3rd person accounts
- discussing a character's feelings, behaviour and relationships
- comparing types of humour, wordplay, joke poems, nonsense verse
- comparing works by the same author
- reading and writing letters for a range of purposes
- using indexes, directories, making summaries and notes
